#### Rules

As the Legacy day is approaching Glenelg is the host club and has many water hazards (18) I thought I would include a couple of rule 26 decisions.

A ball is in a water hazard when any part of it touches the water hazard this includes the stakes or lines used to define the margin of the hazard.

Ball played from water hazard comes to rest in the same or another water hazard.

The player may drop a ball at the point where the ball was last played and play from there playing 4, drop a ball behind the hazard keeping the point where the ball last crossed the margin of the hazard in line with the hole playing 4, play another ball from the tee playing 4. If the player drops the ball in the hazard and then decides he cannot play it he may again drop outside or play from the tee playing 5.

#### The Course

The sooner the 4th green is back in use the better, the temporary 15th green is an absolute disgrace and should never have been presented as a putting surface to play golf on, let us hope that we get better service before the next green is upgraded.
